POLICY

EDUCATION/CURRICULUM

PERTAINING TO HUMAN SEXUALITY

In accordance with Massachusetts Law, Chapter 71, Section 32A, the Tyngsborough Public Schools will notify parents/guardians, via written notification, before any curriculum/material involving human sexual education or human sexuality issues are introduced or discussed.

PROCEDURE

The principal of each building will insure that a timely notice is sent to all parents/guardians advising that upcoming course material may contain human sexual education or human sexuality issues. Parents/guardians will, with reasonable notice, have the right to inspect and review any and all material to be covered and to exempt their children from any portion of said curriculum through written notification to the principal. No child so exempted shall be penalized by reason of such exemption.
